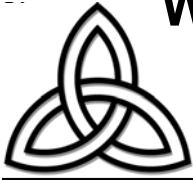

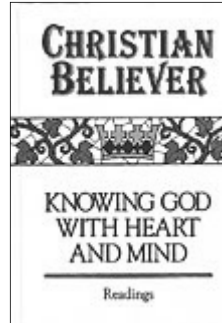

**Music Notes:** The **Prelude** is a setting by Charles Callahan (b. 1951) of the enduring hymn tune MICHAEL by Herbert Howells (1892-1983); Howells wrote it in memory of his only son Michael, who had succumbed to meningitis at age nine. The **Offertory** was composed in 1971 by Gregory Norbet (b. 1940); the refrain (based on Matthew 11:28) begins: "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy-burdened, and I shall give you rest." The **Communion** was written in 1972 by Buryl Red (b. 1936) as part of his "pulpit" musical *Celebrate Life*. We thank Evan Ayars for sharing this modern Communion classic with us today. The **Postlude** is one of ten *Voluntaries* published in 1765 by London organist Henry Heron (1730-1795).

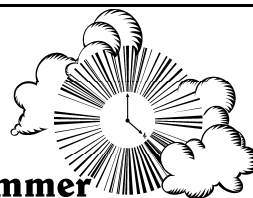
